# 13 August 2018

COO Borka reported on GuideStar for non-profits – The Marine Corps League National Headquarters is now Platinum rated by GuideStar. A good social media link for all Departments and Detachments is LinkedIn. The United States Marine Corps is aggressively pursuing trademark violations. Some examples that require approval from Headquarters Marine Corps are for the use of the EGA, USMC, Marine Corps, Semper Fi, Semper Fidelis, and Oorah. The Marine Corps is also looking at motor vehicle tags that are used by a number of states for Marine veterans that have not been approved by HQ USMC. Wounded Warrior Family Support presentation was made supporting the Dunham House Combat Wounded Care Residence which is named for Medal of Honor Awardee Corporal Jason L. Dunham, United States Marine Corps. Posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for actions while serving with 3rd Battalion 7th Marines during the Iraq War.

"To provide long term care for combat wounded veterans with spinal cord and/or moderate to severe traumatic brain injuries in order for them to enjoy a high quality of life and quality care."

Bylaws and AP Proposed – NJVC Baker spoke in detail about the forthcoming changes to the Bylaws structure and Administrative Procedures updating. Administrative Procedure changes were voted on and approved. These will need to be reviewed by all in the future once completed documents are posted to the MCL National Library.

NJA Griffin spoke about the proposed Bylaws changes.

Proposed Bylaw changes Rejected and Approved were sent out earlier to Mideast Division. This updating may require Bylaws to be updated at all levels once the completed document is posted on the MCL National Library.

Commandant Council was led by National SVC Tobin.

SVC Tobin encouraged all members to use the MCL National Library and the fillable forms. Just remember to download, rename, fill, save, print and distribute hard copies. All completed forms need to be readable.

Department Rosters- Suggestion has been made to establish a new membership database, this should help with a more accurate roster for all Departments. Deceased members are not currently able to be removed from the rosters. National is working on 21<sup>st</sup> Century solutions and technology for our recordkeeping. It will take a while. Marines at Large will be added to the Rosters sent to Departments and Detachments.

SVC Tobin encourages all members to move through the various Elected and Appointed Officers positions available in the Departments and Detachment. Do not stay over the assigned turn limits and to give other members at chance to serve in the various positions. Don't recycle.

Veteran Service Officers- Veterans Administration - You must be a regular member of the MCL and have a letter of recommendation from your Department Commandant. You must complete two training sessions and complete all required VA forms. Once the total completed package is sent to the VA they control the process including completion of request timelines.
